Visit the real high arctic and come face to face with Polar Bears on their level - an experience far more thrilling than seeing them from a ship.

Most wildlife photographers have heard of Baffin Island. It is located in northern Canada, inside the Arctic Circle, and is renowned for its high density of Polar Bears and other wildlife.

Those who have been to Baffin will most likely have been guided by Arctic Kingdom.

Many areas of Baffin are now too populated by tourism or near hunters.

On our tour, we are going to a brand new location on Baffin. This area is well away from hunters and well away from the crowds.

It is very remote, and it takes a privately chartered flight on an aircraft with skis to get there.

We have teamed up with a highly experienced Baffin guide who has researched this area and found a very high density of Polar Bears, Cubs and Arctic Fox.

And because it's well away from hunting pressure, the wildlife is more relaxed which is great news for photographers.

What Makes This Tour So Unique



Polar Bears and Cubs

The main aim of this tour is to help you capture amazing images of Polar Bears in their true high arctic winter environment.

We have timed this tour to coincide with when Polar Bear mums are out with their newly born cubs.

Yes you can photograph Polar Bears in Svalbard from a ship/zodiac or in the town of Churchill, but nothing compares to the experience of actually living on the sea ice and photographing bears on their level, in their world.

On this tour you will spend time in the real high arctic, a vast wilderness of icebergs and snow, travelling across this remote world and witnessing truly wild Polar Bears as they search the tundra for food.



What Other Wildlife Could You See?

As well as Polar Bears, this area of Baffin also has a lot of Arctic Fox. They often come into camp allowing you to capture some wonderful images of them.

While on this tour, you have a chance of also seeing:-

Arctic Hare
Walrus
Caribou
Whales
Baffin Wolves



Watch the Northern Lights From Your Bed

As part of this exciting tour, our team have invested heavily in new state of the art heated domes.

Manufactured in the UK, you will have your very own dome (no sharing needed) which will be your accommodation at basecamp throughout the tour.

The domes are very well insulated and will contain bedding etc to give you a comfortable night's sleep.

Most exciting, if the Northern Lights are dancing in the sky you will be able to watch them while you lie in your bed.

How cool is that?!



The Swamp Rider

Costing just under \$70,000 to buy, our Baffin team have purchased one of these incredible Swamp Rider SRV-Max machines just for these tours.

It can seat up to 6 people, is heated and much more comfortable than a snowmobile. And it can handle any extreme terrain. It's also much more quiet than a snowmobile, making it perfect when working with wildlife.

We will explore the arctic tundra on this amazing machine

Food, Toilet Facilities And More

Meals

You will enjoy home cooked food on this tour, and not your usual expedition boil in the bag meals.

While at Basecamp a hole in the ground will be the toilet, but it will have a seat and will also be inside a tent to give you some privacy.

Charging Facilities

Charging facilities will be available at basecamp giving everyone the chance to charge up their camera batteries etc each day.

The Itinerary

- April 6th - Arrive in Ottawa and be met by David and a polar guide
- April 7th - Arrive into Iqaluit and stay overnight. Transfers, Hotel and meals in Iqaluit included
- April 8th - You will be picked up at the hotel in Iqaluit and taken to the airport. You will then fly on a private charter to land near basecamp in west Baffin
- April 8th - When you land at Baffin, you will immediately go on a half day game drive searching for wildlife
- April 9th, 10th and 11th - full day game drives for Polar Bears and other wildlife
- April 12th - Half day game drive searching for wildlife
- April 12th - You will fly back to Iqaluit on a private charter flight. You will stay overnight in a local hotel and enjoy an evening meal - all included
- April 13th - Fly back to Ottawa

Investment

- £12,450 Per Person (max 4 guests)
- Payment to be held in a trust account in accordance with UK travel law

- Charging points for charging cameras etc while at camp
- Toilet at basecamp (complete with privacy tent lol)

- Travel insurance (you must take this out before travelling with us)
- Photography gear

The Guides

David Gibbon is an award-winning photographer, best known for running winter Arctic Fox trips to Iceland since 2018. He has been highly commended in Nature Photographer of the Year for one of his Arctic Fox images and, in 2023, successfully guided an extreme winter expedition to Ellesmere Island, living in tents in -50 degrees, which is the closest land mass to the north pole, to photograph Polar Bears, Musk Ox and Arctic Wolves. David was again awarded in 2023 in Nature Photographer of the Year, coming 2nd in the black and white category for his epic charging Musk Ox image. In 2025, David ran the first ever land based winter wildlife photography expedition across very remote areas of Greenland on snowmobile. David is founder and director of his own tour company - Wild Lens Nature Tours Ltd - which specialises in arctic photography tours to various destinations including Mongolia, Greenland and Iceland.
